Credit Union Employees Raise Money for Pediatric Brain Tumor Foundation

Moon Township, PA – Employees of Clearview Federal Credit Union helped raise over \$3,300 for the Pediatric Brain Tumor Foundation through several fundraising efforts.

An employee Salad Luncheon was held on August 6, 2007 at Clearview’s main office in Moon Township, PA. Employees purchased tickets to the luncheon for a \$5 donation to the Pediatric Brain Tumor Foundation. Many employee-donated items were raffled off to raise money during the luncheon, including a framed Jerome Bettis autographed “Terrible Towel,” and Pittsburgh Penguins tickets.

Several Clearview employees also participated in the Pittsburgh Ride for Kids on August 12 to raise money for the Pediatric Brain Tumor Foundation. Motorcyclists rode over thirty miles from Cranberry Township, PA to the campus of Slippery Rock University.

“Everyday nine children are diagnosed with a brain tumor,” said Cheryl Snatchko, Clearview employee and fundraiser. “We want to change this.
