Clearview Federal Credit Union Hosts Youth Professional Day

Moon Township, PA— Providing continued support to the community, Clearview® Federal Credit Union recently hosted its first CLAAAY (Career Literacy for the Advancement of All Youth) Professional Day. A total of 18 students from local Beaver County High Schools visited Clearview to participate in professional teamwork exercises and learn about transitioning from high school to college or another chosen career path.

Employees from Clearview's Human Resources and Training departments spoke to the students about the importance of professionalism and communication skills in everyday situations. Several Clearview employees from various Credit Union departments were also in attendance serving as 'speed speakers,' in which they spoke to the students about their own personal high school and/or college education and career path experiences. Each Clearview speaker met with the students in a round table discussion format, rotating to a new table of students after timed intervals.

In addition to the CLAAAY Professional Day, six Clearview employees are currently participating as mentors to students of three Beaver County High Schools, as part of the CLAAAY mentoring program. These employees meet twice each month with students enrolled in the CLAAAY program throughout the 2008-2009 school year.

CLAAAY is a project of Duquesne University's Center for Competitive Workforce Development (CCWD). This program began in 2003 with the goal of impacting the regional economy by providing high school youth in the 'invisible middle' with career information, activities, and guidance to help prepare them to realize their future career goals. During the 2008-2009 school year, CLAAAY is working with 450 students in over 19 high schools across the greater Pittsburgh region.
