Clearview Federal Credit Union Announces Community Service Award Winner

Moon Township, PA— Clearview Federal Credit Union is pleased to announce the winner of their first annual Joseph C. Cirelli Community Service Award.

The Joseph C. Cirelli Community Service award is named in honor of Joseph C. Cirelli, former President and CEO of Clearview, who served the Credit Union for 35 years. This award commemorates the efforts of a worthy volunteer with a \$2,500 donation to the charity of their choice.

Aida Dugan was named as the winner of the first Joseph C. Cirelli Community Service Award for her volunteer efforts at The Ladle And The Hearth, a soup kitchen located in Aliquippa, PA. Since the spring of 2005, she has worked to provide a warm meal to those in need every week. She was one of the founding members of the soup kitchen, and currently serves as its coordinator.

Aida Dugan was chosen from a very qualified field of nominees, who all have logged considerable hours volunteering for their respective charities.

In addition to honoring Aida Dugan for her commitment to community service, Clearview has made a \$2,500 donation to The Ladle And The Hearth. This donation will be used to purchase food supplies for its food pantry, clothes, transportation and lodging vouchers for homeless guests.
