CREDIT UNION EMPLOYEES RAISE MONEY FOR MARCH OF DIMES

Moon Township, PA— Employees of Clearview® Federal Credit Union raised over \$6,000 for the March of Dimes with events throughout March and April of 2008. The largest of these events was an annual March of Dimes walk, held at Brady's Run Park in Beaver Falls, PA on April 26, 2008. Twenty-seven Clearview employees, along with their families and pets took the 3.2 mile walk, raising over \$3,000, which surpassed last year's fundraising total by 38%.

Clearview employees also raised money for the March of Dimes through several raffles and a bake sale, which were held for both employees and members of Clearview. The greatest fundraising event outside of the walk itself was Jean Day, where Clearview employees donated five dollars each for the opportunity to wear jeans to work; it raised over \$1,000 for the charity.
