CREDIT UNION EMPLOYEES RAISE MONEY FOR MARCH OF DIMES

Moon Township, PA— Employees of Clearview® Federal Credit Union raised over \$4,400 for the March of Dimes with events held throughout March and April of 2009. The largest of these events was the annual March of Dimes walk, held at Brady's Run Park in Beaver Falls, Pa., on April 26, 2009. Clearview's team of 45, including employees, their families and pets took the 3.2 mile walk. The Beaver County March of Dimes walk raised over \$72,000 this year. Employees and their families from the Clearview Charlotte branch also participated in a March of Dimes walk held in North Carolina.

Clearview employees also raised money for the March of Dimes through several raffles and a bake sale, which was held for both employees and members of Clearview.

The goal of March of Dimes is to give hope to the families of babies born too soon or with health problems. The money raised supports programs in communities across the country to help moms have healthy, full-term pregnancies. It also funds research to find answers to the serious problems that threaten babies. March of Dimes has been walking since 1970 and has raised over \$1.8 billion to benefit all babies.
