Credit Union Employees Volunteer at *Camp Variety for Kids*

Moon Township, PA – Clearview Federal Credit Union employees recently participated in *Camp Variety for Kids* at Woodlands campground in Bradford Woods hosted by Variety the Children’s Charity of Pittsburgh. *Camp Variety for Kids* is an annual summer day camp program for children with disabilities and their siblings. Thirty-six Clearview employees volunteered at the camp between August 3 and August 7, 2009. The camp provides children an opportunity to experience social stimulation by building and maintaining friendships with other children, camp counselors and volunteers.

Camp Variety for Kids focuses on recreational activities in an outdoor environment while being with their friends, families and volunteers. The children in attendance had fun with arts and crafts, music, swimming, adaptive sports programs and nature walks. Clearview employees and other volunteers helped the kids with activities such as swimming, golf, adaptive bicycling, deck hockey, arts and crafts. The money that was raised through prior Variety “Cares for Kids” charity radiothon helped send children to this year’s camp. The raised money also helped buy the traditional “buddy teddy bears” that were given to each child in attendance at Camp Variety.

Variety the Children’s Charity began in Pittsburgh in 1928. Variety’s mission is to enrich the lives of children with disabilities by insuring that every child with a disability is provided with enabling equipment, assistive technology and communication devices and the opportunity to personally develop and to participate in social, educational, artistic and recreational activities enjoyed by other children. Variety’s Pittsburgh chapter serves all children without discrimination, ages 21 and under, who reside in Allegheny, Armstrong, Beaver, Butler, Fayette, Greene, Indiana, Lawrence, Washington and Westmoreland Counties.
