Clearview donates \$10,000 to the Jewish Federation of Pittsburgh's "Our Victims of Terror" fund

The donation will be part of the United Way of Southwestern Pennsylvania's contribution match of up to \$100,000 to support psychological services, support for families, general services, reconstruction, additional security throughout the community, medical bills for all those involved, as well as counseling and other services that may prove necessary in the future.

Pittsburgh is a close-knit community and seeing how the community has been able to come together during this time of grief shows how strong this city is.
