Clearview raises funds for Beaver County March of Dimes Walk for Babies *Team Clearview FCU walks for research, support and advocacy*

Pittsburgh, PA, May 22, 2019.....(clearviewfcu.org) Clearview Federal Credit Union, a member-based credit union serving 10 Southwestern Pennsylvania counties, participated in the Beaver County March of Dimes Walk for Babies on Saturday, May 11, 2019. The Walk for Babies raises funds to support research, advocacy and programs to improve and ensure the health of all mothers and babies.

The team, dubbed Clearview FCU, was captained by Janine Bottoroff, a Clearview Care Center Manager. This was her first year as team captain for the Walk for Babies.

Clearview's team of 12 employees walked the three-mile course, held on the Beaver County Community College campus. Clearview staff from departments and local branches participated, including Consumer Lending, the Care Center, Information Technology, Community Affairs, Accounting, Digital Experience and the Chippewa and Center area financial centers.

The team walkers raised \$456 and the Clearview financial centers raised an additional \$500 for a total contribution of \$956.

To date, the Beaver County Walk for Babies has raised \$33,609 towards their goal of \$50,000.
