Clearview FCU breaks ground on construction in Moon Twp.

Moon Township, Pa. – Clearview Federal Credit Union officially broke ground on a series of construction projects at its Main Office and branch in Moon Township Thursday afternoon despite rainy weather.

The construction marks the start of remodeling efforts aimed to modernize the entire property at 8805 University Blvd. by adding new technology and simplifying service for members. The project will begin with the relocation of the drive-up area to add video teller machines away from the building in a space that is currently a portion of the parking lot. After continued success with *Clearview Live: The Video Teller Experience* throughout Southwestern Pennsylvania, Clearview will now bring the machines to its Moon campus with a brand new space to house them.

Additionally, Clearview plans to remodel inside the branch and corporate office on the upper floors to allow its team to provide the most personal, convenient service to members and the community.

Clearview’s Board of Directors celebrated with a groundbreaking ceremony on May 25, 2017 in the presence of Credit Union staff and other members of the community, including Bonita Stopperich and James Scott from the office of State Representative Mark Mustio of the 44th Legislative District, and Moon Township Manager Dawn Lane.

Ralph Canterbury, Clearview’s Vice President of Marketing & Facilities, said, “We’ve been in the process of modernizing many of our branches over the past few years, so it’s great to finally be upgrading our headquarters here in Moon where so many of our members come to do business. It’s important for us to simplify and streamline the member experience as new technology becomes available, and we believe these projects will result in the ideal space for convenient service.”

Member service and parking will not be affected at the branch at this time, and Clearview plans to keep members informed throughout the process to avoid any inconvenience.
